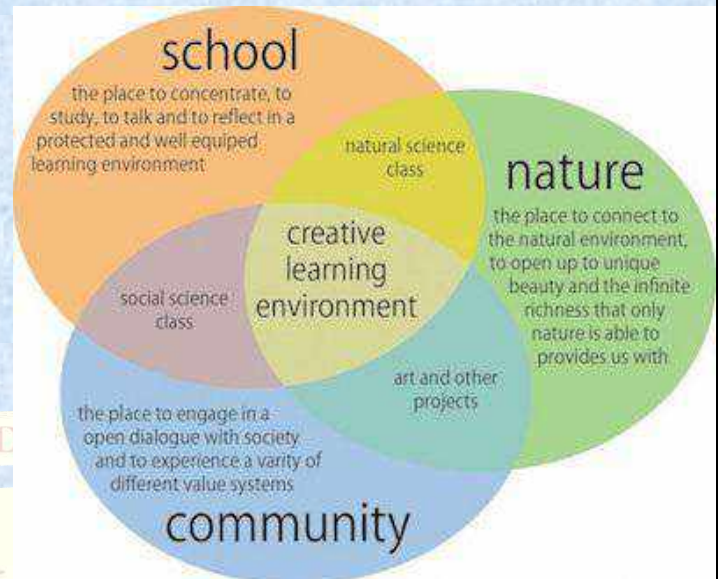

#### **REPORT OF “UDAYAN” PRINCIPALS MEET AT SCINDIA HOUSE -**

**GOLD DUST CONFERENCE ROOM FROM 16<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

#### **Day I - 16.7.2018**

#### **✓ Welcome address, focus on Vision, Mission & Objective of DVM**

The meeting started with a round of introduction of all members present. Our CEO, Dr. R. Williams explored the expectation of each person of this meeting over five days.

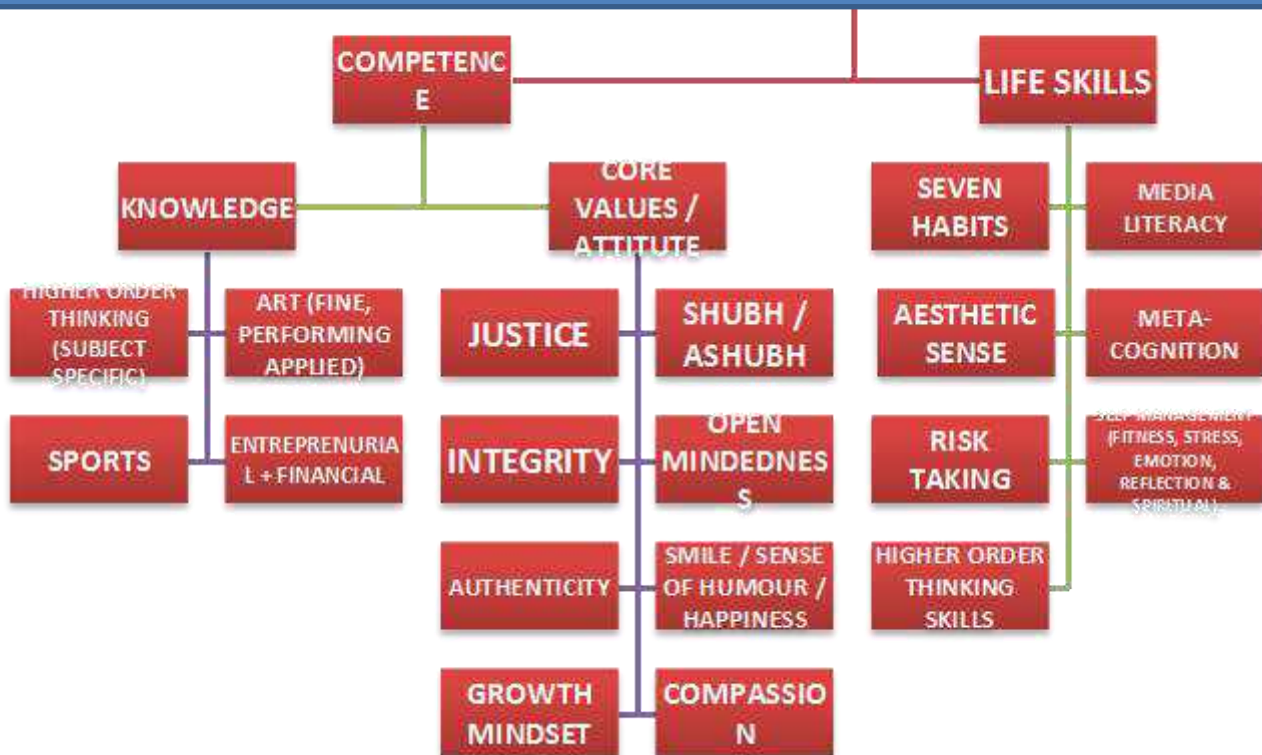
A ground rule and prayer was initiated and agreed upon. A pledge was undertaken.

Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) stressed on the point that we should put our best foot forward to enrol ourselves to the vision, mission & objective of the organization.

Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) advised to understand the need of the organization we have joined. Dalmia follows traditional culture, based on the value system and we have to follow them. Teachers should inculcate the habit of speaking only in English during class hours with the students then only the students will improve their English speaking.

✓ **The Core Promise of Dalmia School Group:**

**EMERGING DALMIA STUDENT PROFILE (MAIN TRAITS: LEADERSHIP**



Core Promise of Dalmia Schools was rolled out for implementation in the curriculum as well as in the students. **Our unique distinctive parameter of student development was the emerging Dalmia Students Profile.**

Education at the Dalmia schools ensured that every child was equipped with Knowledge, Life Skills & Core Values/Attitude.

Individual files mapping each child's progress was to be ensured and the records would be clubbed each year to ensure the emerging student profile.

The academic goals plan would also have the implementation of the Dalmia core promise of the HERITAGE CHAIN OF DALMIA SCHOOLS.

✓ **Expectations Setting Session:**

The following are the targets for the year 2018-2019.

- 1) Standardization of all systems and processes in the schools.
  - 2) Bench-marked standards.
  - 3) Uniformity of curriculum, uniformity, website, teachers training, ERP.
- ❖ Teachers training - Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) asked the Principals about the changes seen in the teachers after the training in two schools - Chirawa and Rajgangpur.
  - ❖ Delegation of duties/responsibility of a Principal is not advisable, to avoid detention of standards. Principal has to take note of all the teachers how they teach, how they behave with the students in the classroom, whether LP is observed on daily basis as per the appraisal table.



- ❖ Appraisal system to be done for each teacher before any increments.
- ❖ WRFC - What is Right for the Child, should be put on all the boards in the classroom, reception area, etc.
- ❖ ERP started in all schools for smooth running of operation of schools. One person should be devoted with one special room having Wi-Fi connection. Principal to ensure ERP implementation.
- ❖ Curriculum and Academics Goals (Quarterly).
- ❖ Principal has to maintain each student's file in the school comprising of all details of the student.
- ❖ While recruiting teachers, written test is mandatory. Appointments should be made only according to the Recruitment Policy.
- ❖ Teachers should inculcate the habit of reading books, internet, CBSE site should be viewed on daily basis so that they can be updated on daily basis as per the present requirement of the school.
- ❖ Admission target has to be achieved.
- ❖ Grasp all opportunities that come your way for higher level in future.
- ❖ Principal should have cordial relation with neighbouring school Principals for mutual help.
- ✓ **Presentation on Economic Viability and Fees Structure**

Capt. Pillai, Principal Dalmiapuram presented points about the Co- Scholastic and Extracurricular activities in the Schools.

He also spoke about economic viability and fees structure.

✓ **Importance of Policies, SOP and Financial Manuals:**

As manuals were circulated beforehand, the principals presented the importance of Policies, SOPs and Financial Manual in two group.

Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) then orientated following points:

- ❖ Financial manual to be implemented at 360° by Principal. Principal should check budget, bank reconciliation (Weekly report to be sent to CEO), fee collection/pending, all statutory compliance like ESI, PF, salary payment, AMC payment / timely renewal, all agreements like Uniforms, Books, transport, etc.
- ❖ Logo - should be printed on all pages, letterheads, should be put up on the reception area.
- ❖ Vision, Mission and Objectives - should be printed in all school diaries so that each student will come to know about the value of these three.

**Day II - 17.7.2018**

✓ **Branding a School is important or not?**

The day started with a prayer by all members present.

Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) put the focus on Branding of School by raising the question 'Why branding is important?' Branding is done in school to create a happy satisfied atmosphere in the school:

- ❖ Institutional branding by creating academic, recruitment, parent support, IT, ERP - 360-degree plan should be very powerful to achieve what we want.
- ❖ Talk to staff regularly, word of mouth is very important.
- ❖ Verbal instruction to teachers is not advisable, always give instructions in writing only to prove authentic, true, real accountability, responsibility and judging on how/what they are doing to identify the teacher who hates to do what you are talking about.
- ❖ Principal should be visible everywhere, nurture the staff. Be conscious about the DVM family, their values and reputation of the brand.
- ❖ Principal also should be computer savvy. Branding to be done through internet, social media, professional FB and be a member of linked-in, FM, advertisement etc. Individual website should not be promoted.

✓ **School Audit:**

PPT shown regarding audit, Dr. R. Williams, CEO (DVM) explained in detail the importance of audit. Audit is as per SOP, quality standards and quality assurance.

**Second Audit will be structured in month of October (Dates will be Conveyed) @ all Dalmia Schools.**

✓ **Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP):**

Followed by the detailed session on ERP Systems by Mr Smarth & Mr Vaibhav.

Following points emerged during the meeting:

- ❖ There should be a single point of contacts in all schools
- ❖ Student Detailed Report will be generated and distributed to Principal, teachers for their verification and corrections. There should not be a single mistake in the data entry.
- ❖ Following facilities will be given in the ERP:
  - SMS alerts
  - Circular formats for parents
  - Result format
  - Payment of Fee
  - Absenteeism etc.
- ❖ There should be an ERP operator in every school.
- ❖ Teachers to put the attendance on daily basis and SMS to parents will be sent only by one authorized person.
- ❖ Pending details of students to be submitted to Entab office ASAP.



- ❖ Entab team will provide hardware requirements for every school.
- ❖ An undertaking to be taken from all staff for their confidentiality of all credentials.
- ❖ No PDF files to be allowed for printing by parents.
- ❖ There should be a link of ERP on school website.

Online payment option to be integrated with the banks at respective locations.

**Day I - 15.05.2019**

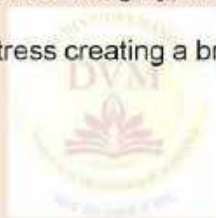
**Welcome address, focus on Goal Setting 2019- 20 - Dr. Rosetta Williams- CEO (Dalmia Vidya Mandir)**

- 4) Values: Our ceo reinstated DVM values: Integrity, Trust & Respect, Humility, Commitment.

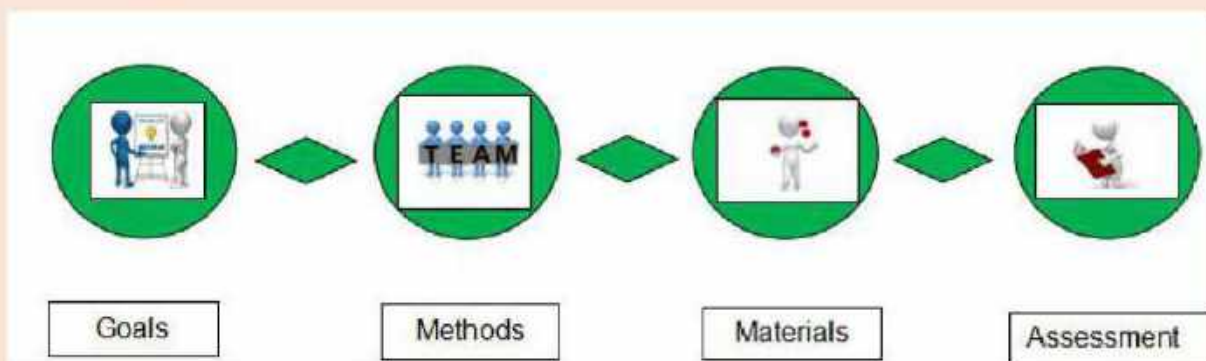

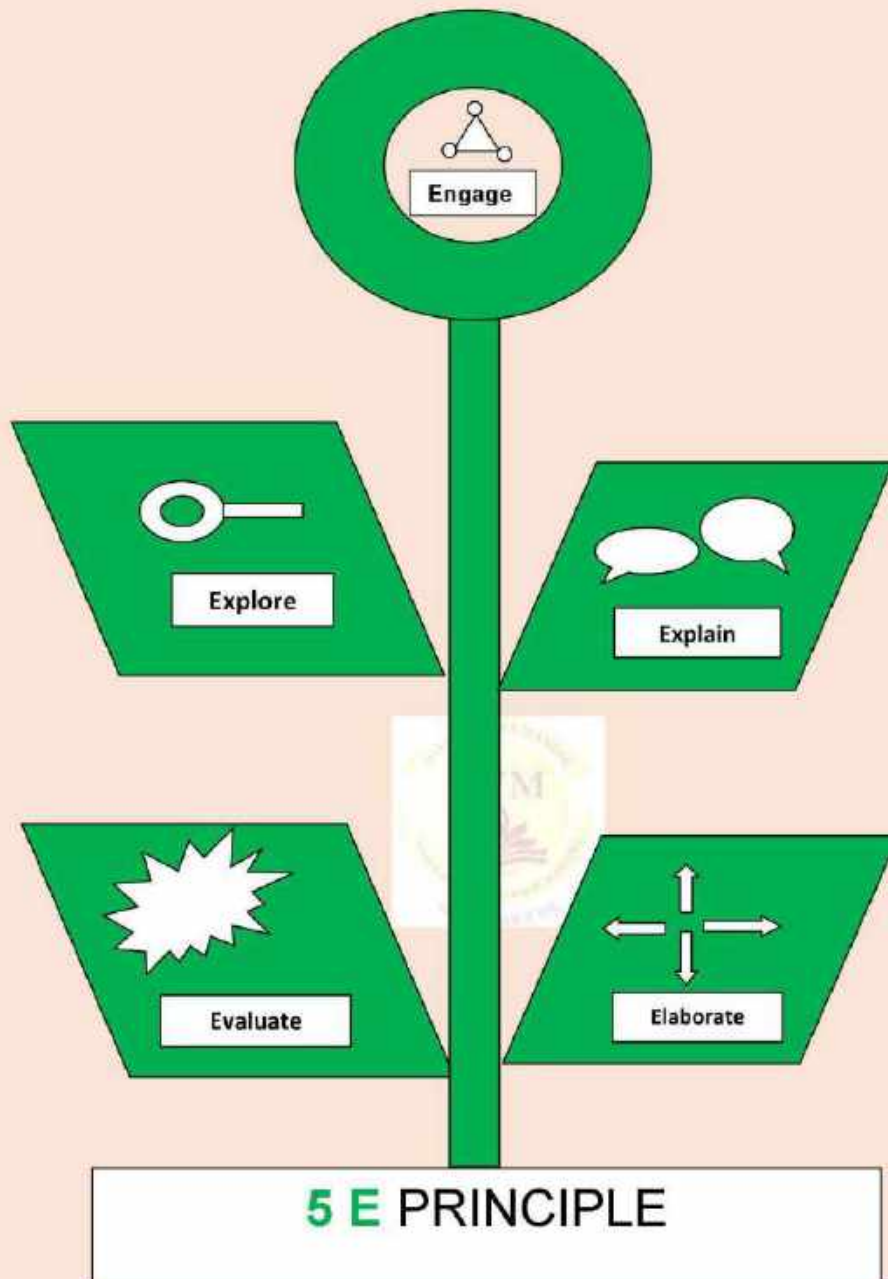
