





### Achievements



## For Implementation:

- Teachers will provide a list of students and the percentages of their test scores to date.
- Academic improvement of 65 percent for each child is the target, regardless of the subject.
- To Do, Doing, and Done sheets that should be posted on each staff's action board.
- Everyone must take standup time each day and participate in the principal's rounds and enrollment.
- The Principal will assess the teachers' weekly reviews and documentation, and students who require remedial instruction will be allocated to classes.
- In an academic setting with documented evidence of improvement, teachers will discuss their students' progress in groups to the parents.

- So, what does it look like when a school fully commits to the five strategies described above?
- The improvement process becomes a system owned by everyone, not just a select few - and in the end, students have benefitted immensely.
- By embracing distributed responsibilities, weekly progress metrics, documented processes, regular leadership inspection, and daily feedback on goals for improvement, principals have empowered the entire school.



# RTE Implementation in DVM Schools

### Performance of EWS students in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic Areas

In the academic sessions of 2022-23 at Dalmia Vidya Mandir schools, a total of 328 students appeared for the 10th board examination, with 125 students hailing from the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and 203 from the non-EWS category.
