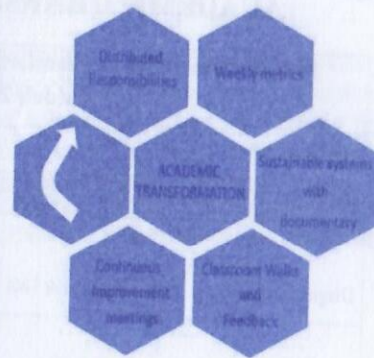

## DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Any act of indiscipline by the student/s will invoke strict disciplinary action against the defaulter(s). He / She will have to face discipline committee who will decide the appropriate action as deemed fit. The school has a system of issuing warning cards to the defaulters as per the details given below:

**BLUE CARD: A Blue Card will be issued (for a week) in the following cases**

- Improper Uniform.
- Tidiness.
- Late comers.
- Regular absentees.
- Absence without prior information.

After observing the student during the tenure of punishment, the concerned teacher(s) will remark on his/her attentiveness or improvement. If the progress is satisfactory, the blue card will be discontinued; otherwise its period will be extended further for a week. Failure to show any improvement even after two weeks of punishment will lead to the issuance of YELLOW CARD.

\* Parents to sign. an undertaking.

**Yellow Card: A yellow card will be issued (for a week) in the following cases:**

- Damage to school property. Minimum Rs. 500/- will be charged as fine (depending on the severity of damage more may be charged).

A Yellow Card holder will not be allowed to avail any programmes in the school during the period stipulated on the card. The student will not be allowed to attend any programme, picnics or outings. The students will report to the respective class teacher during break time and PE period for detention. The defaulters will be made to sit in the Library/Art Room and detention register will be maintained by the librarian.

Failure to show any improvement even after the issuance of Yellow Card may lead to the under mentioned disciplinary measures:

- Step I: Detention during break.
- Step II: Suspension from school for a two days.
- Step III: Issuance of Red Card.

### INTERNAL TRAINING

A teacher training program is a program that equips teachers with techniques and modern pedagogy strategies that helps them to better connect with, manage, and teach to their students in a manner which ensures that all students are learning and benefitting.
