


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WHEREAS the Settlor of the Trust is desirous of creating a trust for the benefits of the people of Bihar and other parts of India in general with the aims and object noted below in the clauses of this Deed of Trust and wants to declare a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) as the initial corpus of funds as Trust property for the objects hereinafter mentioned.

WHEREAS the Settlor of the Trust for the control of management and dealing with the affairs of the Trust, requested the Trustees named hereinafter to be the Trustees of this Trust and they have consented to act as trustees under these presents.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

The Settlor of the Trust do hereby create and constitutes a trust for the objects detailed hereunder and hereby endows a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) as the initial corpus fund and the Trustees hereby acknowledge the receipt of the same and for the objects stated hereinafter mentioned.

- 1. NAME OF THE TRUST:** The name of the Trust shall be "DALMIA VIDYA MANDIR SAMITI TRUST".
- 2. CORPUS OF THE TRUST/TRUST FUND:** The Corpus of the Trust shall be Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only), i.e. the initial contribution by the Settlor and it will be increased by other donations/grants/gifts etc. such as money, assets, properties whether movable and/or immovable properties and other investments etc. Corpus will be enhanced by accumulated income and reduced by disposition in the manner as provided in this Trust Deed.
- 3. OFFICE OF THE TRUST:** - The Office of the Trust shall be at Company High School, Banjari, P.O.-Banjari, P.S.-Rohtas, Distt. -Rohtas, Bihar-821303, or such other place changed from time to time as may be decided upon mutually by the Trustees through a resolution passed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- 4. THE TRUSTEES OF THE TRUST:** The said Settlor of the Trust has appointed the following persons as Managing Trustee and Trustees to manage the affairs of the Trust:

5. The management and control of the Trust and Trust properties shall vest in the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall comprise not less than three (3) trustees and there will not be any maximum limit, including the Managing Trustee and President/Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer(if any).

6. The Trustees will be entitled to receive specific subscription/donation/grant etc. from any body corporate, body of individuals, company or any person above the age of 18 years belonging to any religion caste or creed who accepts the aims and objects and agrees to abide by rules and regulations of the Trust and to admit such person to any of the following categories of membership of the Trust.

a) DONORS: All those who donate and agree to donate to a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) or above to the fund of the trust can become Donors.

b) FOUNDER MEMBERS: -Those people whose name is found in the Trust Deed on the date of registration will be referred to as a Founder member.

7. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE TRUST: -

The Trustees shall apply the Corpus/Net income of the Trust including voluntary contribution received by the Trustees or any other person, which are in the nature of Trust receipt (after payment of the rates, taxes, assessment and all other outgoing in respect of the Trust Estate) for the purpose of public Charity and Socio Economic & Educational Development in particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the Trustees shall be at liberty to apply the Trust Estate and/or the Corpus/Net income of the Trust for anyone or more of the following objects and purposes and the Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivors of them or other Trustees or Trustee hereof for the time being, will hold the said sum of Rs. 1,00,001/- (Rupees One Lac One only) made over by the Settlor, to the Trustees as aforesaid and all gifts, contributions, subscriptions, donations, grants, foreign contribution, bequeaths and other moneys or properties as and when the same shall be paid to, acquired by, or vested in them and the moneys, investments, properties and all accumulated income for the time being representing the same and which may from time to time form a part of the Trust Corpus/Fund, to apply the same for the relief of poor,

medical relief of poor, medical relief, education, publications and the advancement of any other objects of general public utility not involving the carrying on the any activity for profit in the territories of India or for a charitable purpose which tends to promote international welfare in which India is interested, provided however, not part of the said fund or income thereof be applied for any purpose outside India except in accordance with the approval of the Central Board of Direct Taxes/Government of India and for such purpose (without restricting the generality of the foregoing objects) to do all or any of the following:

- a) To establish and/or maintain and/or grant aid to schools, including public schools, colleges, general/professional/technical and other educational institutions training centers such as medical colleges and hospitals, dental colleges and hospitals, physiotherapy and rehabilitation institutes, veterinary colleges and hospitals, Para medical and nursing courses, agricultural colleges and research institutes, and Training Colleges, institute of technology including polytechnic and computer training institutes, teacher's training colleges and other vocational training center, university to impart general modern professional and technical educational to the deserving youth of the society without any discrimination whatsoever for that after being educated and trained at these institutions they may get employment in their respective field and thereafter may substantially contribute to the development of the nation as worthy sons and daughters of the nation.
- b) To establish, maintain and grant scholarships, prizes, stipends, grants, etc. in aid to poor deserving Students, orphans or other needy persons without any distinction of caste, creed and religion, sex or place or birth.
- c) To establish, maintain Dharamshalas, Rest Houses, Hostels and construct Park and other institutions as they shall in their uncontrolled discretion think fit or the benefit of general public but that establishment and maintenance never be for the purpose of trade and profit except for charitable purpose.
- d) To undertake project and schemes and to establish and maintain Libraries including Reading rooms, Book banks for poor children, Community centers, Youth clubs, MahilaSamiti in rural, tribal and urban gleam area and to public magazines and journals and also to establish sports clubs and Athletic centers for development of sports and athletics activities and proper mental and physical development of the rural and tribal youth.
- e) To establish, develop maintain yoga schools, colleges, universities and other institutions for the improvement of human

race in general without any distinction of religion, caste, creed, sex and place of birth.

- f) To establish support, maintain or grant or aid to different branches of engineering colleges, schools, training centers, hospitals and nursing homes, allopathic medical and dental hospital and ayurvedic medicines center and hospital, child care and maternity centers and such other institutions or as the Trustees may think fit and proper for the purposes of relief or aid to poor or needy.
- g) To grant relief on the occurrence of earthquakes, floods, famines and other calamities and general distress and to give donations to other institution or institutions doing similar relief work.
- h) To establish, support, maintain and aid worship places of all religion and organize devotional programs for all caste, creed and religion.
- i) To establish, support, maintain and aid boarding houses and hostels and other institutions or boarding and lodging of needy deserving students of all caste and creed.
- j) To establish, support, maintain and aid boarding, houses and other public charitable institutions and also to open maintain rest house, park club and recreation ground for public benefit and to supply water and electricity either free or at concessional rates for public benefits.
- k) To establish, maintain and support homes for poor or needy widows, destitute, orphans, old age people's home or otherwise to support them and to do all acts, deeds and things for their relief, maintenance and upliftment.
- l) To establish, maintain, promote or assist institution having public charitable and/or socioeconomic and educational objects or to grant donations for public charitable social and/or educational purpose as the Trustees may in their absolute discretion, think fit.
- m) To organize health care centers, blood donations and eye camps and to create health awareness specially for prevention of AIDS & Cancer and to popularize family planning and birth control devices through seminars, workshops and lectures.
- n) To take up schemes and projects to create public awareness about legal rights including fundamental rights to form Co-operatives of the people under the 97th Constitutional Amendment Act, 2011, Consumers Protection Act etc., Human Rights Act, Harijan Atrocities Act, Dowry Prohibition Act, and to take up program to supplement and implement public welfare programs and policies of the Central Government and the State Government for upliftment and development of Advisees and other oppressed and suppressed classes of the Human Society.

e) Such other public charitable and/or educational/medical purposes as the Trustees may, from time to time, think fit.

PROVIDED THAT any one or more of the objects specified in this clause are held not to be the objects of a Public Charitable and/or educational/Medical nature, the Trustees may not carry out such object or objects, but validity of the Trust created by these presents as a Trust for Public Charitable Socio-Economic and/or Educational and medical Purposes shall not be affected in any manner. For the purposes of these presents, the expression "Charitable Purpose", "Educational Purpose", "Socio-Economic Purpose", Religious Purpose, Co-operative Societies Purpose and "Medical Purpose" shall have the same meaning as is assigned to that expression in the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification or enactment and reenactment thereof for the time being in force.

8. All the activities shall be Non Profitable and shall be done on 'No Profit No Loss' basis.
9. All the income, earnings, movable/immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and Objects, only as set forth in this deed of the trust and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus, profit or any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member or trustee of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members or trustees. No members or trustees of the trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership or trusteeship.
10. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
11. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in this deed unless the other object added to the trust objectives.
12. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust and Trustees shall get the accounts of the Trust audited by a practicing Chartered Accountant every year.
13. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year, ending on 31st March every year.

14. That the day-to-day works and substantial powers of Board of Trustee will be vested in and be designated as "Managing Trustee".

15. Subject to the Provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust Fund or any portion thereof as they may in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, without being answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other party for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property including buildings and/or in the purchase and acquisition or mortgage in India, of free-hold or lease-hold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any Scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm or an Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit and in the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882 shall apply. Also, in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage, they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion. The Trustees shall have power, if any be it in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part thereof and any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc. and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trust and with the subject to powers and provision including all the possessors contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as shall be then subsisting and capable of taking effect.

16. BENEFICIARIES OF THE TRUST: -

The beneficiaries of the trust shall be the people of India in General and/or people of Bihar and/ or any deprived Community in particular by way of getting education, training and other benefits. However, the benefits of the Trust shall be confined to its aims and object.

18. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

That for the furtherance of the Trust, the trustees shall have the following powers: -

- a) The Trustees have equal right with regard to the functioning of the Trust. They will come to decisions through a process of consensus. In case of a difference of opinion, the Managing Trustee shall have a casting vote;
- b) To apply for Income tax PAN (permanent account number) and other requirements, if any;
- c) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription etc. in cash or in kind, from any person, body of persons or any trust, with or without conditions, within India and from the person, body of persons or organization of foreign contribution under FCRA.
- d) To apply the whole or any part of the Income of the Trust, or the Trust Fund or accumulations thereof, to any one or more of the objects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- e) To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
- f) To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- g) To let out, disposing off any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and let out on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- h) To open Bank Account(s) in the name of the Trust, with a Bank or Banks, to operate such account(s) and to provide for opening and operation of such account(s) by Managing Trustee of the Trust or by an agent appointed by the Board of Trustees.
- i) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound refers to arbitration, all actions, suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
- j) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or Managing Trustee or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment.
- k) To make, amend, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.

- l) To set and/or allocate the whole or a part of the Income or the corpus or the Trust Fund or any part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- m) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other trusts or other entities having same or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and inconformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- n) To give aid by way of donations or grants out the Income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies organizations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for the like aims and objects mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution societies, organization or Trustees to start/maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- o) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- p) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes/aims/objects of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- q) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliations and other assistance with a view to promote the objects of the trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, Public and other Body Corporates, Companies or Persons, Scheme and other Works and matters within the objects of this Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payment may be made.
- r) To take over, purchase, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having object either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- s) The Trustees of the trust are empowered to carry out the aims and Objects of the Trust and as per the decision of the Board of Trustees from time to time.

- z) The Managing Trustee in confirmation of the Board of Trustees shall execute the documents relating to properties movable or immovable or otherwise to secure to repay the loans obtained by the Trustees and enter into contracts and agreements which are not detrimental interest of the Trust.

26. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations: -

- a) The Trustees may have meetings of the Trust with a quorum of Three whether present in person or telephonic / video conference participation as and when they deem fit.
- b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees. The Trustees have equal right with regard to the functioning of the Trust. They will come to decisions through a process of consensus. In case of a difference of opinion, the Managing Trustee shall have a casting vote;
- c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds (2/3rd) of the Trustees shall be valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees. Seven (7) days' notice shall be given to the Trustees of such meeting, notice period may be waived.
- d) In case of urgent matters, they may be decided by circulation among the Trustees; however, the said issues shall be ratified at the immediate next meeting of the Board of Trustees.

27. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusively provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these present.

If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provision of the Deed of Trust, the Managing Trustee may by circulation or otherwise make such provisions if it appears to be necessary or expedient for removing the doubts, not inconsistent with the Aims and Objects embodied in the Deed of Trust.

30. DISSOLUTION OF TRUST: -

In the case of dissolution of the Trust, the remaining assets of the trust after clearing off all the liabilities shall go to any Charitable Trust having similar objects as well as registered under Income Tax Act, 1961 as decided by the Board of Trustees at the time of dissolution of the Trust.

31. JURISDICTION OF THE COURT: -

In respect of Administration or other matter of Trust the dispute shall be preferable to the Court/Judicial authorities situated at Patna (Bihar) where the activities and functions associated with the trust are principally to be conducted.

32. OTHER TERMS: -

Unless the context otherwise requires, in this Deed:

- a) Words using the singular or plural number also include the plural or singular number, respectively;
- b) Words denoting any gender shall include all genders;
- c) Reference to any statute or regulation made using a commonly used abbreviation shall be construed as a reference to the title of the statute or regulation;
