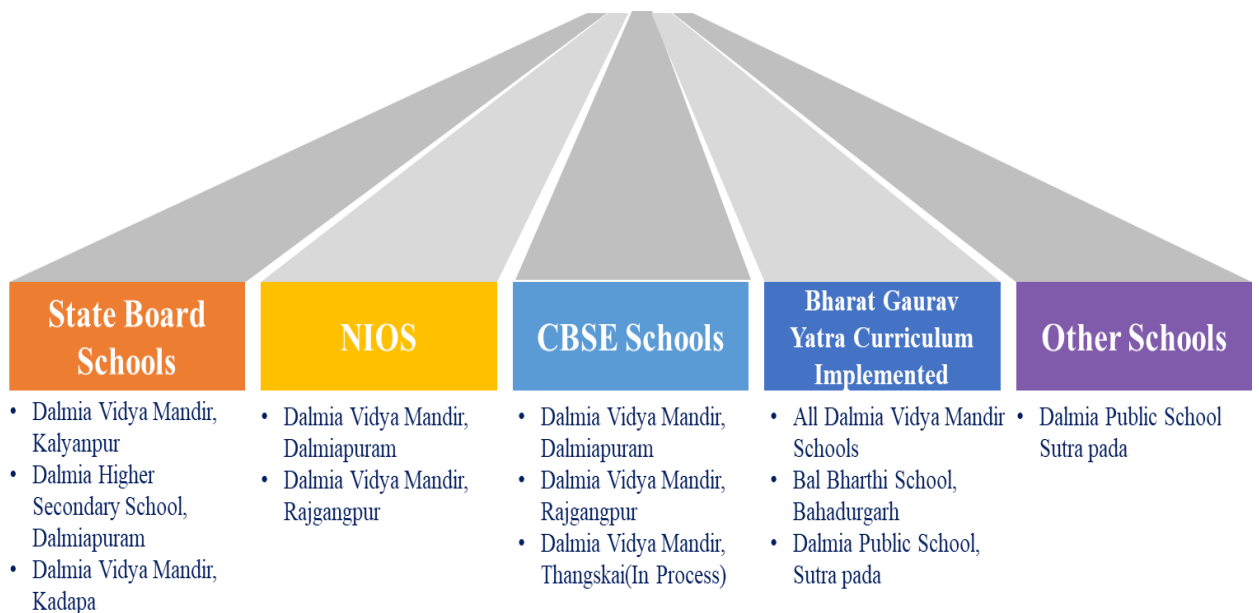

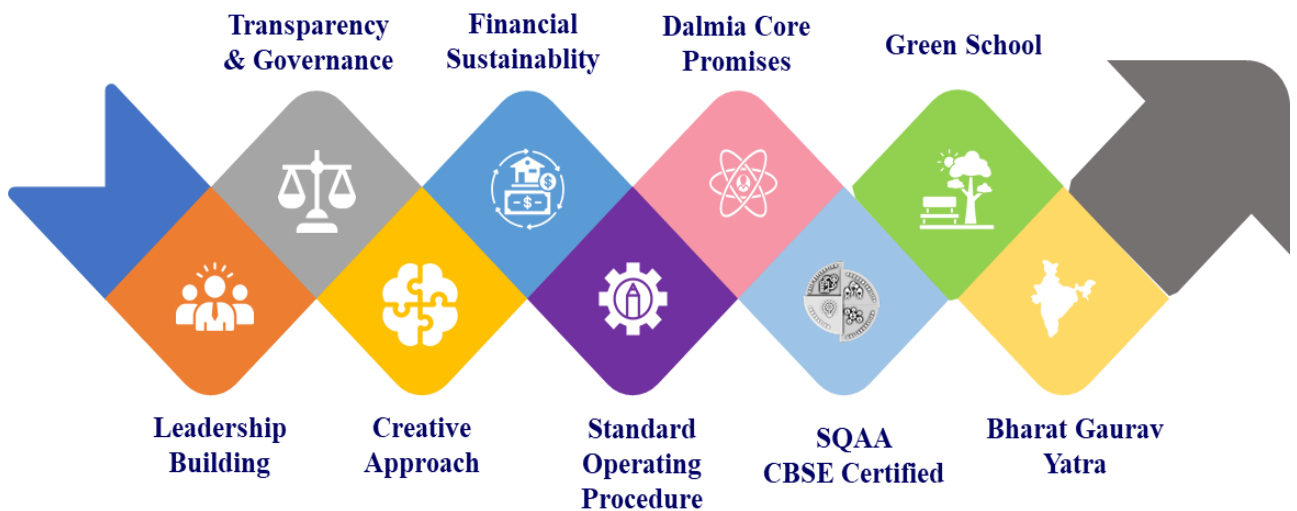

# Strategic Governance

The Head Office (HO) serves as the strategic epicenter of the DVM network, orchestrating complex administrative, financial, and pedagogical workflows. The 2025-2026 session saw the HO intensifying its oversight through the implementation of advanced Management Information Systems (MIS) and the standardization of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) across all branches.

## **Financial Integrity and Third-Party Validation**

In an unprecedented move for an educational trust, the DVM network has adopted Tier-1 corporate audit standards. The KPMG audits, self-financed by the Dalmia Vidya Mandir Foundation (DVMF), represent a commitment to radical transparency. These audits, conducted at key locations such as DVM Rajgangpur and DVM Dalmiapuram in late November 2025, focused on operational efficiency, financial accountability, and the integrity of the ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) systems.

The financial oversight mechanism extends beyond annual audits. The HO exercises regular finance control through weekly review meetings where budgets are meticulously evaluated against actual expenditures. As of the final quarter of 2025, the budgets for the upcoming 2026-2027 financial year are already under review, ensuring that the expansion goals of the network are backed by robust fiscal planning.

# Human Capital and Capacity Building

The DVM HO has prioritized the professionalization of its workforce. Throughout 2025, the recruitment and induction of new staff continued smoothly, with a specific focus on background verification and alignment with the "Dalmia Core Promise." Training sessions conducted in August 2025 addressed critical areas such as Daily Routines, Confidentiality, Ethics, and School Safety Norms, ensuring that every staff member—from the principal to the housekeeping team—is a stakeholder in the school's success.

The Teacher Appraisal Framework has been updated to move beyond traditional observation. It now incorporates the Academic Transformation Cycle outcomes, where a teacher's performance is intrinsically linked to the diagnostic test results of their students. This data-driven approach ensures that "teacher empowerment" is not a vague concept but a measurable outcome of professional development sessions.

## *School Reporting System: Promoting Transparency and Operational Excellence*

The School Reporting System implemented at Dalmia Vidya Mandir Schools is a specially developed internal digital platform created via google forms that helps track day to day staff activities across all campuses.

# Academics

## *Academic Transformation*

The "Academic Transformation 2025" initiative is the flagship pedagogical model of the DVM network. It is designed to move away from rote learning toward a cycle-based intervention model that addresses the specific learning needs of every child.



## **The Cycle-Based Intervention Model**

The transformation process is divided into distinct cycles, each approximately 40 to 60 days in length. This rhythm allows for frequent "course correction" based on empirical data.

- **Phase 1: Diagnostic and Baseline Establishment:** Launched on April 3, 2025, this phase utilized initial diagnostic tests to establish the baseline for every student. This allowed schools to categorize learners and design remedial pathways early in the session.
- **Phase 2: Targeted Intervention:** Commencing in July 2025, this phase focused on intensive curriculum delivery supported by periodic tests. This cycle continued through September, with a focus on blending letter sounds and numeracy patterns in early years.
- **Phase 3: Advanced Rigor and Pre-Boards:** Starting in October 2025, this cycle prepared senior students for board examinations while continuing the holistic development of primary students through the "Bharat Gaurav Yatra" (BGY) curriculum.

## *Curriculum Innovation and the BGY Model*

The Bharat Gaurav Yatra (BGY) curriculum is an integration of national heritage into the daily academic schedule. It aims to instill patriotism and pride in India's cultural and scientific achievements. In 2025, the curriculum was enriched to include the life stories of visionary reformers and the sacrifices of national heroes, ensuring that "national pride" is a lived experience in the classroom.

### *National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)*

Key objectives of NIOS implementation:

- To provide an alternative and flexible mode of education.
- To support students with diverse learning needs and circumstances.
- To ensure continuity in education without academic disruption.
- To promote inclusivity and equal learning opportunities.
- To prepare students for higher education and career pathways.

In the Academic Year 2025-26, DVM Rajgangpur enrolled 11 students And DVM Dalmiapuram enrolled 12 Students.

## *Smart Class and Digital Learning*

Smart Class and Digital Learning at Dalmia Vidya Mandir represent a progressive step towards creating interactive, engaging, and technology-enabled classrooms.

Through smart classrooms, lessons are enriched with audio-visual content, animations, simulations, and interactive modules that simplify complex concepts and cater to different learning styles.

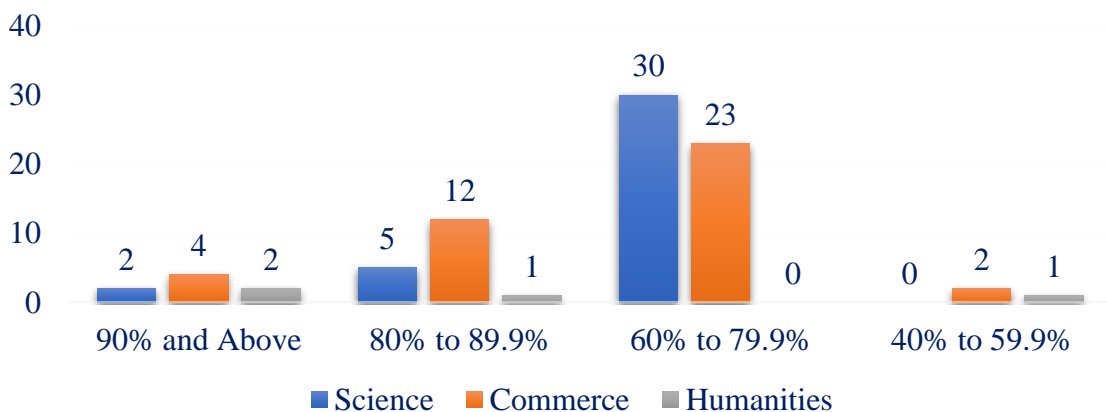

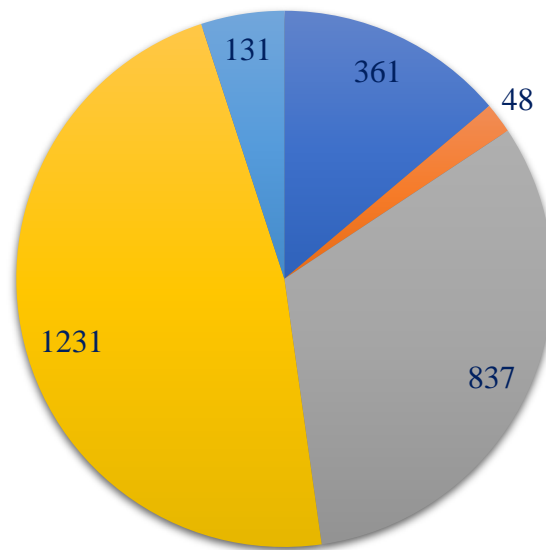
