





It aims to evaluate core concepts, application of knowledge, and higher-order thinking skills, aligning with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. Our CBSE-affiliated schools—Dalmia Vidya Mandir in Rajgangpur, Chirawa, and Dalmiapuram—are implementing SAFAL guidelines. Dalmia Vidya Mandir, Rajgangpur, served as a pilot school for SAFAL in the 2023-24 session.



STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics)

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) represents an interdisciplinary approach to learning and problem-solving. At Dalmia Vidya Mandir schools, STEM integration is key to the curriculum, involving hands-on activities, projects, and experiments that develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills through real-world applications.
